

Llangorse Fun Ride

Booking Terms & Conditions

1. General

- a. These Terms and Conditions apply to the booking of a Fun Ride (the 'Fun Ride' or 'event') and any ancillary products provided by Llangorse Multi Activity Centre. They should be read in conjunction with our main Terms & Conditions of Booking available at <https://www.activityuk.com/more/terms/>
- b. By booking a Fun Ride with us, you confirm that you have read and agree to these Terms and Conditions.

2. Booking

- a. Bookings for the event must be received in advance, either using the online booking system or by calling 01874 658 272.
- b. Booking shall only be deemed as accepted when accompanied by payment in full and payable by debit or credit card either online or by phoning our booking office.
- c. If you do not have a booking, you will be refused entry to the event.
- d. Both yourself and each member of your party will be required to read and sign our online disclaimer and risk acknowledgement prior to the day of the event. A copy of the disclaimer can be found at <https://www.activityuk.com/fun-ride-waiver/>
- e. Riding is a risk sport. As with all sports, Llangorse Multi Activity Centre strongly recommends you take out a personal accident insurance.
- f. All riders must abide by the Fun Ride Rules, a copy of which can be found below.

3. Cancellation

- a. You can cancel your booking for the event anytime up to 48 hours before your booked start time and shall be entitled to a full refund.
- b. Cancellations received within 48 hours of your booked start time will not be entitled to a refund.
- c. If it is deemed necessary to cancel the event, Llangorse Multi Activity Centre shall use all reasonable endeavours to notify you as soon as possible. If it is deemed possible, the event will be reorganised so as to take place at a subsequent date and time. If you are unable to attend the reorganised event, you shall be entitled to a full refund but no other compensation shall be payable.
- d. Clauses 5.5 and 5.6 of our main Terms & Conditions of Booking also apply.

4. Covid-19

- a. We will have appropriate safety measures in place to prevent the spread of Covid-19.
- b. The event will be held in accordance with Welsh Government Covid-19 guidance and regulations in force on the date of the event. We ask all attendees to familiarise themselves with current Welsh Government Covid-19 guidance in advance of the event.
- c. Don't visit with symptoms - Please **DO NOT** come to the event if you or any members of your household have symptoms of coronavirus including a persistent new cough, temperature or sudden loss of taste or smell. You should contact us to cancel.
- d. Should you require close assistance from one of the event staff, we will require you to wear a face mask - please bring one with you.

- e. It may be necessary to cancel the event at short notice should measures be reintroduced to prevent the spread of coronavirus. See clauses 3.c and 3.d.
- f. Llangorse Multi Activity Centre strongly recommends that you take out appropriate travel insurance in case you are forced to change your plans.
- g. If we are required to do so at the time of the event, we will maintain an accurate list of all visitors to assist with the Welsh Government's Covid-19 Test, Trace, Protect strategy. Your details will be held in accordance with data protection legislation and our Data Protection Policy.

Fun Ride Rules

RIDERS

- All riders must ensure they are wearing a hard hat, fastened, at all times when mounted and this must be to an appropriate recognised standard. All riders must also wear the correct footwear for riding.
- All riders must sign the disclaimer when entering the ride.
- All riders must be prepared to set off strictly between the given start times.
- All riders must wear the arm bands provided by the organisers at all times when riding the route.
- All riders must follow the directed route.

HORSES AND PONIES

- All horses and ponies must be a minimum of 4 years old
- All horses and ponies must be in good condition and be fit enough to carry out the work required.
- All horses' and ponies' hooves must be shod or dressed correctly.
- All tack worn must be in a safe, serviceable condition.

GENERAL

- An adult must accompany all children under the age of 16.
- The organisers must be informed of any change of rider after the entry is made and any extra entry fees paid.
- The decision of the ride organisers is final.
- The ride marshals' instructions must be adhered to at all times as they are there for the health and safety of all.
- It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure the last steward receives your number at the finish.
- The exact indicated ride route must be kept to – stay on paths and do not stray onto farmland or maintained grass/lawns or verges.
- Follow the countryside code at all times – no litter, close all gates.
- Please remove rubbish and horse droppings from around your trailer/lorry and take it home with you!
- When approaching other riders please slow to a walk – when coming from behind please warn them of your intention to pass.
- Photographs of the event may be used to promote future events at Llangorse Multi Activity Centre. If you do not consent to this, please email us prior to the event.
